

EMBA

The EMBA Program is designed for business professionals currently working full time. Courses are offered on weekends. Courses offered are identical to those of the regular MBA program and are taught by the same faculty. A minimum of 37 credits of required courses plus a master's thesis are required for the EMBA degree in Finance. A minimum of one years of full time work experience in a related business area is required for consideration for admission to the EMBA program. The program's emphasis is the same as with the regular MBA program.
